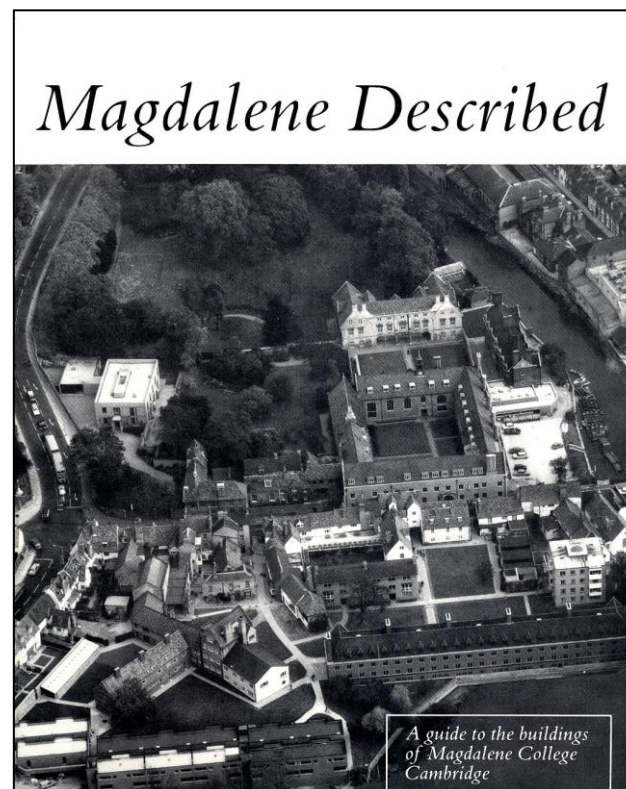
A GUIDE TO THE BUILDINGS OF MAGDALENE COLLEGE

Offering an insightful commentary on both the external fabric and the internal arrangements of the College's highly varied architecture, it is at once a scholarly history and a lively guide.
